



ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Languages: We will only accept abstracts in English, but full papers will be accepted in English and Spanish.

Title: Titles must be as precise and concise as possible.

Abstracts: Abstracts must not exceed 300 words and shouldn't include any personal or institutional information of any of the authors. If you're uploading a PDF file, please make sure no personal information is included in the file's metadata (such as the author's name or institution). Abstracts or papers that don't comply with this requirement will be rejected.

IMPORTANT: Acceptance to the Conference will be based on peer-reviewed abstract submissions.

IMPORTANT: Authors can only be responsible for one submission under their name; however, they can be included as co-authors in other submissions as well. For co-authored submissions, only the first author listed will be considered as the one responsible for the submission. If an author submits more than one abstract under the same name, only the first one received will be considered as received.
